What's the story?

Permit To Work software has previously been separated from risk assessment, isolations management processes and dangerous goods management. eVision have now integrated these into one single safe system of work. The integration and realisation of these processes builds greater organisational efficiency and effectiveness.

Permit to work is a proven method to ensure hazardous work is not carried out without safeguards in place. A good PtW system ensures everyone is aware and has thought about the hazards of the job. Grinding, needling and welding in an area with flammable materials are just some areas where a permit to work and isolation/override certificates are required. In the past a Permit to Work form was just and only used to set conditions. The industry is changing, growing and becoming more complex. Outside contractors, like welders, divers, wire line operators without local installation knowledge are used. While the PtW system is growing, the overview is lost.

Permit Vision was developed by eVision to clear up this situation.
